### Joint Admission Test for M.Sc.

#### ABOUT JAM

Joint Admission Test for M.Sc. (JAM) 2018 will be held on February 11, 2018 (Sunday) for admission to M.Sc. (Two Years), Joint M.Sc.-Ph.D., M.Sc.-Ph.D. dual degree, M.Sc.-M.S. (Research)/Ph.D. dual degree and other post-Bachelor degree programmes at IITs (Bhubaneswar, Bombay, Delhi, Dhanbad, Gandhinagar, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Indore, Jodhpur, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras, Patna, Roorkee and Ropar) for the academic session 2018-19. JAM score will be used by IISc Bangalore for admission to the integrated Ph.D programmes. However, JAM score will also be used by other Institutions for admission to their programmes. JAM 2018 is open to all nationals. But, foreign nationals will be required to satisfy the rules and regulations of the admitting Institute(s) pertaining to foreign students for admission.

JAM 2018 is being organized by IIT Bombay. All correspondence related to JAM 2018 must be addressed to Organizing Chairperson, JAM 2018, GATE-JAM Office, IIT Bombay, Powai, Mumbai 400076.

Test Papers and Mode of Examination : JAM 2018 will have seven test papers, namely, Biological Sciences (BL), Biotechnology (BT), Chemistry (CY), Geology (GG), Mathematics (MA), Mathematical Statistics (MS) and Physics (PH), each of three hours duration. For all the papers JAM 2018 examination will be conducted in ONLINE mode only. A candidate can appear in either one or two test papers subject to the restrictions of test schedule given below and by paying an additional fee for the second test paper.

#### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

• At least 55% aggregate marks without rounding off (taking into account all subjects, including languages and subsidiaries, all years combined) for General/ OBC (NCL) Category candidates and Foreign nationals; at least 50% aggregate marks without rounding off (taking into account all subjects, including languages and subsidiaries, all years combined) for SC/ST and PwD Category candidates in the qualifying degree.

• For candidates with grades in letter/ CGPA (instead of percentage of marks) the equivalence in percentage of marks will be decided by the admitting institute(s).

**Note:** Proof of having passed the qualifying degree with required eligibility, as specified by the admitting institute, should be submitted by September 30, 2018.

**Reservation policy is as per Government of India norms.**

#### JOINT ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission to the above mentioned academic programmes in IITs for the academic session 2018-19 will be made on the basis of all India merit list of JAM 2018. Candidates who qualify in any test paper of JAM 2018 shall be eligible to apply for admission to all the academic programmes corresponding to that test paper, provided they also satisfy the minimum educational qualifications and the eligibility requirements, as specified by the Institute(s) in which the admission is sought. After the declaration of JAM 2018 results, qualified candidates shall be required to apply to the Organizing Institute (IIT Bombay) specifying their preferences for the programmes for which the admission is sought. **Candidates should note that being in the merit list of any test paper neither guarantees nor provides any automatic entitlement for admission.** Further details regarding admissions, prescribed fees, etc., will be updated on the JAM 2018 website.
